LOOKING FORWARD – Ready to Learn provides over 3,500 newborn support kits to mothers each year through the neonatal units of UW Health and OSF Saint Anthony. Our kits emphasize attachment building, literacy and play. We know that strong attachment creates a foundation for all other learning, that reading opens doors to the world and that play creates a vital connection between child and caregiver and helps children personalize learning. In the year to come, look for the installation of Read, Play, Learn family play areas springing up throughout our community. These areas will offer access to books, toys, information and resources and promote bonding, literacy, and play.
